Established in 1962 the ANU Classics Museum is one of Canberra's cultural gems. The collection spans the Mediterranean and beyond. The objects are beautifully displayed and range from fine Roman glass tableware and jewellery, ancient pots dating back 5,000 years, beautiful glossy Greek vases, Greek coins from the time of Cleopatra and Roman coins depicting Julius Caesar, to domestic ware and interior decor from Pompeiiian villas destroyed by the eruption of Vesuvius.
