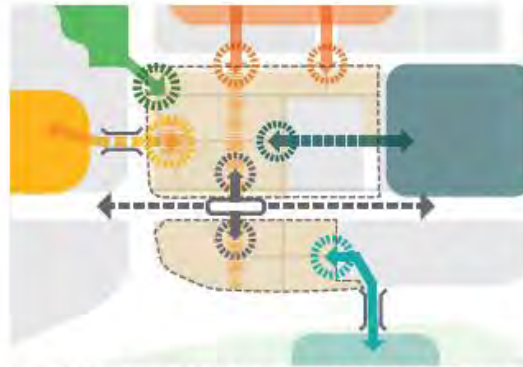
A lively precinct that **showcases** UNSW's globally recognized **identity**, and the specific identity of the new Canberra campus, to the city and the world

A **connected** precinct, deeply integrated into its context, which allows safe and clear access to the neighbouring city centre and adjacent partners



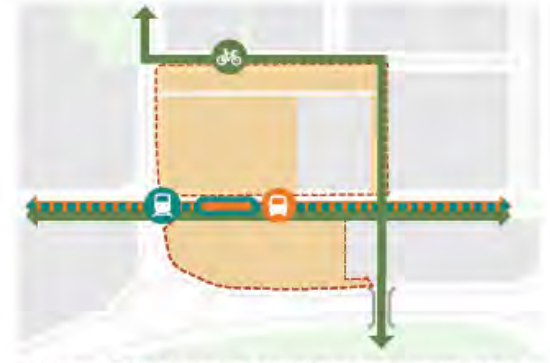

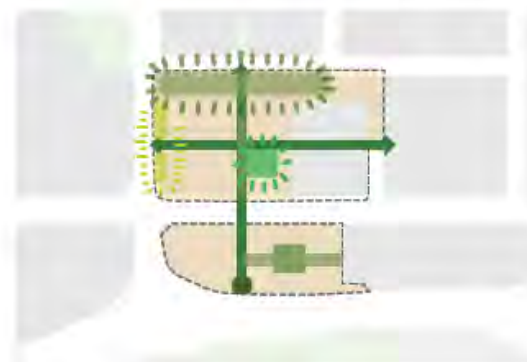
A precinct of nurturing and inspiring **public spaces** which embrace the rich context both natural and built
