

## Construction notification

New traffic lights are being installed at the intersection of Limestone Avenue, Treloar Crescent and Euree Street in Campbell to replace the existing pedestrian signals and improve road safety.

Construction commenced on Wednesday 19 July 2023 to ensure necessary closures of Treloar Crescent could take place ahead of scheduled closures associated with the Australian War Memorial Redevelopment Project.

In addition to new traffic lights, this project will remove the existing pedestrian signals north of the intersection and provide additional dedicated right-turn lanes in both directions on Limestone Avenue at the intersection.

This project is funded under the Australian Government's Black Spot Program. Road crashes are a major cost to Australians every year. Black Spot projects target those road locations where crashes are occurring. By funding measures such as traffic lights at dangerous locations, the program reduces the risk of crashes.

### Upcoming work

Site establishment is underway with the site compound to be erected at the north-east corner of the Limestone Avenue and Treloar Crescent intersection within the southbound nature strip. Temporary traffic management including roadwork signage and associated bollards and barriers are also being installed.

Construction works commenced on **Wednesday 19 July 2023** with a closure of Treloar Crescent at the intersection of Limestone Avenue to enable removal of the concrete median on Treloar Crescent. This closure will be in place Monday to Friday between the hours of 9.30 am and 2 pm and on weekends between the hours of 8 am to 5 pm for approximately two weeks (weather permitting). Access to Treloar Crescent and Campbell High School will remain in place during this time from Fairbairn Avenue.

We acknowledge this is short notice however this first stage of works is required to commence immediately to ensure it can be completed ahead of the Australian War Memorial Redevelopment Project closures.

Work will be carried out as dayworks only between the hours of 9.30 am and 4 pm Monday to Friday. If required, limited work may be undertaken on weekends between 8 am and 5 pm. Construction is expected to take five months to complete (weather permitting).

### Traffic and pedestrian access

In addition to the initial closure of Treloar Crescent at Limestone Avenue, there will be single lane closures in both directions on Limestone Avenue through the intersection during construction, as required, between 9.30 am and 4 pm. These lane closures are required for the safety of our workers and members of the community. In addition, through movements from Treloar Crescent to Euree Street and right-turn movements may be temporarily unavailable to allow construction activities to be carried out.

Pedestrian access will always be maintained however temporary detours may be in place at times to safely facilitate access around the construction works.
